

Beauty by Taisiya – Microblading treatment Booking terms and conditions

Upon booking, a deposit of £50 will be required to secure your booking. Until I receive the deposit, unfortunately I can only hold the appointment for 24 hours. If I haven't received the deposit after 24 hours, the appointment will be made available again for others to book that slot.

I understand everybody is busy and there are some situations we can't control. So, if for any reason you have to cancel, 48 HOURS NOTICE is required. Your deposit is still valid if you rearrange your appointment within 4 weeks. If you don't book within 4 weeks of cancelling your appointment (subject to availability), your deposit will be kept. If you have rearranged twice (either once within the 48 hours notice) you will have to pay the full treatment amount before rebooking.

My first priority is to look after you as a client and sure your whole experience is fabulous, however as you will understand, my time is also precious. © Deposits are non-refundable and cannot be used against any other treatment.

As discussed, within your first treatment price, a free top up is included which is to be booked for between 4-8 weeks (ideally) after your first treatment. You have up to 15 weeks after the first treatment to have your top up as the pigment will not hold and the process will have to start again from scratch. After this time, £75 will be charged.

A patch test is required 48 hours before so that treatment can go ahead. A patch test is available either at the shed, or home delivered. I will need your

home address to send it to you if you require it to be sent there. A scratch test can also be done on the day of treatment.

A medical consultation form is to be filled out and sent to me as soon as possible so I can check you are eligible for treatment. You can find the medical form on my website, details will be sent upon booking. This along with a patch test is essential to go ahead with treatment.

If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, treatment can only go ahead 3 months after. Treatment CANNOT be done if you're:

- Pregnant
- Diabetic (GP referral)
- Have rosacea
- Have impetigo
- Are on Acne medication (1 year clear)
- Having cancer treatment
