

Eyebrow Aftercare

The aftercare procedure is really important, it is as important as the treatment itself. The correct aftercare procedure is necessary to achieve the best results. If this is compromised in any way this will affect your healed result. Keep in mind that in many cases some unevenness of colour is to be expected. This is the purpose of the retouch (colour boost) appointment. Included in your initial treatment price as discussed in your consultation is one retouch only; ideally 6 weeks after Microblading or Blade and Shade and ideally 4 weeks after Ombre Brows. Any additional retouches needed after this will be charged at a fee of £75 within the first 7 months from your original first treatment date.

For the first evening after treatment, ice packs protected with a cloth may be applied onto the area to ease swelling. You may experience the following for 72 hours after treatment:

- Tenderness
- Dryness
- Itchiness
- Puffiness

For the next two weeks, NO:

- Sweating
- Swimming
- Sunbathing
- Sunbeds
- Saunas
- Direct shower spray
- Water
- Makeup in the applied area

Daily procedure for the next two weeks:

- 30 minutes after your treatment please wash the treated area with cool boiled water using a clean cotton cosmetic pad to remove any blood and lymphatic fluid from the area.
- Please repeat this, two more times, leaving 2-hour intervals in-between if possible.
- After that, dry heal for the next 13 days. This is very important for your healed results. THE ONLY EXCEPTION is the healing balm provided. Use this once a day, VERY sparingly. Only a

small, grain of rice size is to be used. If you feel the area getting saturated with the balm, skip a day. We need a fine balance between keeping them moist but not too moist, and not dry. Use your discretion but please do not over saturate the area with the balm.

- If you do accidently get the area wet, you must gently pat dry with a clean tissue.
- I recommend you use a gentle facial cleanser to clean the skin around the treated area during the healing period. You must not attempt to apply any makeup, creams, ointments on your treated area.
- Some itching is normal. DO NOT PICK, PEEL OR SCRATCH the treated area as the colour may heal unevenly and you risk scarring and infection. Allow the wound to flake on its own.

Long term care

- Use a good sun screen, sun exposure and sunbeds will fade your cosmetics.
- Avoid using harsh exfoliating products on your cosmetics.
- If you are planning a chemical peel or an MRI scan, please inform your GP of your permanent cosmetics. Metal elements are in the pigment, which may cause tingling
- Please inform the national blood service if you donate blood as you may not be eligible. (Only within a certain time frame, usually 6 months).

Please note a colour boost does not include a second retouch after 24 months, the price will go back to full price as it will need to be retouched twice (second visit).
